Back in 1936 when the Credit Union was formed, the first office was actually located inside the Fort Wayne General Electric plant in Building 16-2. Eventually, the young Credit Union needed more space and secured leased office space near the plant. In 1946, the Credit Union was located on the corner of Broadway and Taylor. Later, it relocated to the present site in a moveable office at 1021 Swinney Avenue--just off Broadway.

In 1969, a 1-story permanent structure with a basement was built across from the GE Broadway plant on Swinney Avenue. As the credit union grew, this building was expanded. Eventually, 2 drive up lanes were constructed in the back to provide more convenience for members. Old nearby structures were torn down to accommodate additional parking and a free-standing 24/7 drive-up ATM.
