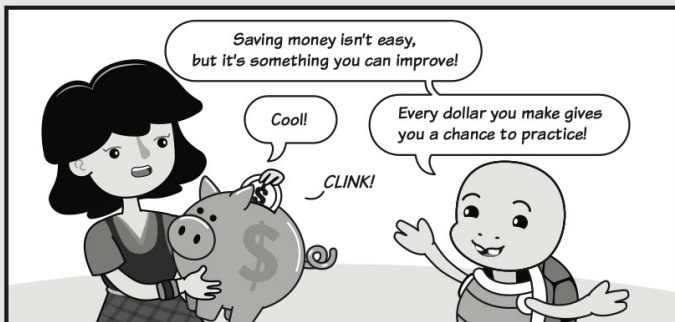
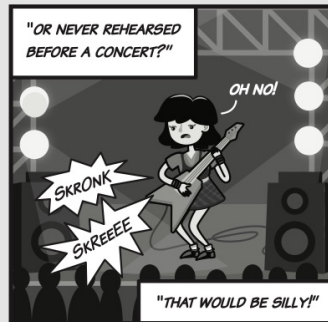
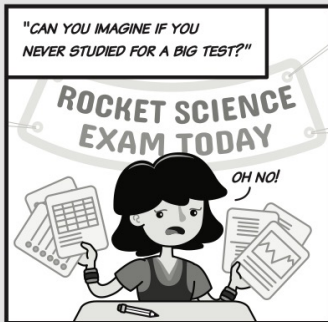
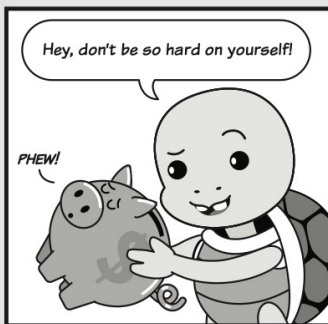
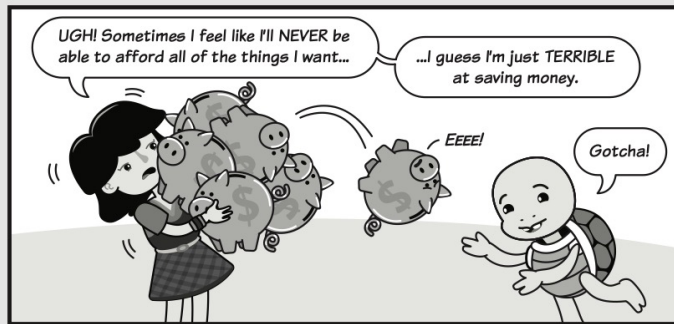


Saving Money

Save Small, Dream Big

Hey Kids! It's your month! National Credit Union Youth Month is celebrated every April. This year's theme "Save Small. Dream Big. at your credit union" is a reminder of how saving even a little now can pay off big later. The most important thing is to start saving. After all, a mighty oak tree began as an acorn.

Here are some tips to help you get started saving towards your big dreams:

- Set a goal. When you get money for doing extra chores or as an allowance, tuck part of it away. Deposit it in your Youth Savings share at the Credit Union so you won't be tempted to spend it on something else. Do the same with any gifts of money you get on your birthday or at the holidays.
- Make your dream more real by finding or drawing a picture of it. Glue the picture to a jar. Then save your spare change in the jar and watch it add up.
- Ask a parent about a match. For example, if you can save \$10 per week, ask if you can have a percentage matched, say 50% or \$5 per week.
